The Paul Bartlett trophy will be awarded to the winner of the match. Current champion is Glenn Edgard who received the first-ever Paul Bartlett Trophy award in April, 2006. ## **COWBOY ACTION SHOOTING (CAS)**

CAS is the fastest growing shooting sport around; it is not only national, but international. Have you ever watched the old West movie, and thought about how you would like to do something like, being a "John Wayne, Gene Autry, Clint Eastwood or even Hop-along-Cassidy". Well with our group you can live in the old 19th century as an old West character. This can be a fictional 19th century figure from a Zane Gray book or how about a US Cavalry or Army sergeant in Blue or Gray, here your chance to roll back the clock.

Well, what are you going to need to get started? Two (2) single action revolvers, one (1) pistol caliber lever action rifle, and one (1) shotgun without ejectors. Shotgun can be of side by side with or without external hammers, or a pump shotgun of the Winchester 1897 or lever action of the Winchester 1887. For the pistols and rifle; I would suggest that you keep them in the same caliber; doing this will cut the chance of loading the wrong ammo into the firearm.

Let's assume you will want something resembling Colt Single Action Army, you can find different replicas and clones. You can find clones or replica revolvers from around \$250 and up. If you should buy used check it over or you might have to take it to a good gunsmith to have it worked on. Be careful, there are good buys out there. If you have a Ruger Blackhawk, this will work fine if the caliber is of 32 to 45. A Ruger Blackhawk will place you in what is known as the Modern Category, with its adjustable sights, with the use of smokeless or black powder. A lot of shooters use the Ruger Vaquero, with its fixed sight places them in the traditional shooting class with smokeless powder or Frontier category using black powder cartridges. Ok, there are many companies making single action revolvers; such as EMF, Ruger, Taylor, Uberti, American Western Arms, and Cimarron. Now for the rifle, it must be from the 1860 to 1894; this covers the 1860 Henry, 1866, 1873, 1892 Winchester and 1894 Marlin.

Come and attend a match. Talk to shooters; we are a friendly group and you will find CAS people will be more than happy to get you started in the sport. After watching a shoot, you will find shooters willing to allow you the opportunity to get the feel of the old West.

Come on out on the 2nd Sunday of each month at 8am and have some fun. For more information check the Greenwood green sheet for scheduled shooting events.
