SPEAKER: JERRY PATTERSON, TEXAS LAND COMMISSIONER

Born in Houston, Texas on November 15, 1946; Graduate of Texas A&M, Class of 1969; received commission in the Marine Corps; Vietnam -1972; Naval Flight Officer & Marine fighter squadrons until his retirement from the Marine Corps Reserve as a Lt Colonel in 1993. Patterson is a life member of VFW, American Legion and Vietnam Veterans of America.

Past State Senator; District 11 (Harris, Galveston, Brazoria); **major legislative successes include passage of the historic concealed handgun law**, a constitutional amendment allowing home equity lending, the state coastal management plan and the creation of the Texas State Veterans Home Program; he chaired the first Veterans Affairs committee in the Texas Senate and hosted the first POW/MIA day at the Texas Capitol.

Jerry and his wife Jennifer reside in Austin. Four children, with one having served as a Marine attack helicopter pilot in Iraq.
